- All visits have to be 10 consecutive working days excluding travel. Weekends are not included.
- The International Office at Uppsala University will book and pay for airfare, one return ticket in economy class between Arlanda, Sweden and your home destination.
- You or your home university has to cover costs to and from the airports and any visa costs if applicable.
- Your scholarship is 160 EUR per day in Sweden plus 224 EUR for two travel days.
Total: 2464 EUR
- Unfortunately we cannot arrange accommodation for you but we will recommend suitable hotels.
- All visits have to take place between May 1, 2016 and February 28, 2017.

Staff exchange

All employees of partners of Uppsala University Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility are eligible to participate in Staff Training, including teaching staff if they intend to use the time for professional training rather than teaching.

Visiting staff are expected to work and be present at the workplace (except during meetings) five full days a week (Monday-Friday). Uppsala University is an informal and non-hierarchical workplace. You are expected to conduct your work independently, meet deadlines and attend and be on time for meetings. You will be under the supervision of an experienced staff member and that supervisor/contact person will be happy to answer any questions that you may have. If you fall ill or are unable to come to the office you have to report this to your supervisor.

The working languages are Swedish and English. Swedish language skills are not required for the placement. However, advanced English communication skills, oral and written, is expected.

You do not need to attach an invitation letter to your application but you have to define what department or office you want to visit at Uppsala University in your application. We will make arrangements with that unit if you are accepted.

Teaching assignment

You are required to teach (lectures, seminars or tutoring) at least 16 hours during the 14 day (10 working days) time period.

Please attach a letter of invitation from Uppsala University to your application.

Next step

After the deadline your application will be reviewed and you will be notified of the results no later than one month after deadline.

The deadline for applications is March 31, 2016.

All applicants have to attach a letter of support from their supervisor/head of department or office.
