

How can I Apply?

Am I eligible?

In principle the programme is open to internal and external participants belonging to the countries of L13 Cambodia, Myanmar, Mongolia, Vietnam, Laos.

Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, China

In addition participants from Sri Lanka, India, Maldives, Philippines, North Korea are considered if belonging to the partnership.

Are to be considered Internal participants (**Target Group 1**) the candidates belonging to the listed partner Universities and are considered external participants (**Target Group 2** and **3**) participants belonging to associate partners and to the civil society.

How many kind of grants are available?

There are many combinations depending on the length and target groups, and **5 different types of scholarships**. As external you can apply as **Master**, **PhD** and **Post doc** Researcher. As *Target Group 1* you can apply also as **Undergraduate** or **Staff**.

Could you tell me how can I register?

Where can I download the **Application Form**?

The form is not to be downloaded, you must complete the online form at <http://one-more-step.eu/en/How-to-Apply/Submit-your-application/> and upload your CV and requested documents.

May I use Asian **fonts**? The form must be filled with Latin characters (western fonts)

My **citizenship** is not listed in the form.

It means you are not eligible for OMS.

Is there any threshold of **English** exam?

The required level of English is set in the *Academic offer* of each institution see each partner page (section Partner <http://one-more-step.eu/en/>).

You may be tested by the home and host university.

What Is the **Pick password**?

It is a password you may decide and use to enter and modify you application till the final deadline.

My **Home University** is not listed.

It means you have to add it filling the space in **Other** and you must apply as TG2 or TG3.

What should I write in "**Contact details of advisor/coordinator**" do you mean the *Academic or Administrative Coordinator* in my home university?

We already know the names of Coordinators, also published on line. What is asked for in the Application form on line is the name of the person you are in contact for the project: it could be one of Coordinators you find on line, or a different University advisor.

Applicant status Is your position at present

Type of Scholarship requested,

corresponds to the kind of mobility you are looking for

How to fill **Scholarship duration** (months) ?

The length of the mobility must correspond to the scholarship offer for the call available in <http://one-more-step.eu/en/Mobility-Programme/General-scholarships-distribution/>

Motivation and impact on **sustainable development**

The answer to the QUESTION "What is the **sustainable development relevance**/component of your mobility?" is an abstract of the contents of your Motivation letter: you have 200 characters available.

What **Fields of study** should I indicate?

There is a pop down menu with 16 options: you must choose the most suitable among them, also referring to the Academic offer of the hosting institution and/or the main title including the one of your interest in the Table on line <http://one-more-step.eu/en/upload/Mobility/Study%20fields.GIF>

Who must write the **Letter of Reference** ? the Professor who supervised my previous study or the Coordinator in my home university?

The *Letter of Reference* should be issued by any professor who knows you well; the higher level, the better.

What are the **Documents** to be uploaded?

Different documents are requested, based on the kind of scholarship you are applying for. All the required documents are listed In Selection process and Criteria at <http://one-more-step.eu/en/Mobility-Programme/Selection-process-and-criteria/>

How can I Apply?

CV Europass is a special European template for your Curriculum Vitae.

Transcript of record, is a certification issued by your University stating your Academic career: years of study; courses taken and marks obtained.

The Letter of motivation one page A4 in English will focus on two questions:

- How does the Erasmus Mundus mobility contribute to your personal and professional development?
- How should/could your mobility contribute to the sustainable development of your Home country from the cultural, social and economic perspectives?

The Letter of Reference or L. of recommendation This Letter should be issued by any professor or responsible referent who knows you well; the higher level, the better.

Letter of support Invitation from the Supervisor of the hosting University

Learning Agreement is a document identifying the courses you plan to

follow at the hosting institutions. It must be consistent with your profile and comply with the Academic offer at the chosen host Institutions. It must be filled with the support of the home and host academic supervisors, to avoid the risk your academic activity abroad is not recognized when you return back home.

DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED

Undergraduate and Master BA/MA

1. CV + Transcripts of records or diplomas + language certification.
Language skills, should comply to the requirements of the host institution and / or programme
2. The letter of motivation one page A4 in English
3. Letters of recommendation are not needed for BA/MA
4. Copy of Passport, to be uploaded in jpg or Pdf
If you do not have any passport yet you can upload any other Identification document (with name and surname and a picture where we can understand who you are)

5. Learning Agreement must be filled with the support of your home and host academic supervisors
A revised Learning agreements for exchange BA / MA will be compulsory requested before the mobility will take place.

PhD and Post-doc

1. CV including language certificates, academic titles and publications
2. The Letter of motivation as above
3. The Letters of recommendation
4. Letter of support Invitation from the Supervisor of the hosting University
5. Copy of Passport, as above
6. Project proposal (study/ research programme)

The formal acceptance of the Study / Research programme from a Doctoral school and/or research supervisor at the hosting institution may be requested for PhD and Post-doc candidates.

Academic staff

1. CV stating language skills and including Teaching and/or working experience
2. Letter of motivation as above
3. Letter of acceptance must include a detailed *Work or research plan* with the endorsement of the hosting institution and the invitation to the Host University in case the candidate is selected
4. Copy of the Passport, as above

PLEASE BE INFORMED

If any of these documents is missing in your application it will be considered as incomplete and will not be eligible for the selection process.
